

Play Worker Opportunity at Lighthouse Women's Aid

I would like to present an immediate short term opportunity to provide play work support to our Children's Team over the summer holidays when we will be running a busy Summer Play-Scheme

The days required for the Play Worker role include these 12 dates:

Tuesday 24th July; Wednesday 25th July; Thursday 26th July; Monday 30th July; Tuesday 31st July; Wednesday 1st August; Thursday 2nd August; Tuesday 7th August; Thursday 9th August; Tuesday 14th August; Thursday 16th August; Tuesday 21st August; Thursday 23rd August; Tuesday 28th August and Thursday 30th August.

The key points to bear in mind are that a suitable qualification/experience is required. DBS is required. References will be required. A job description is attached for information.

The Play worker post is currently vacant and therefore this could lead to a longer term contract until September 2020 following completion of application form and interview.

The longer term post is as follows

Children's Play Worker—based in Ipswich 15 hours per week
Salary £6,365.00 per annum (£8.16 an hour) plus pension:

Play work is a very important aspect of refuge services provision. Whilst women are being supported their children need parallel opportunities to recover and settle. Your role will involve planning and delivering a variety of play sessions across the age groups, you will provide assistance to the CYP transitional Worker and be adept at engaging in play, activities and holiday play schemes suitable for children in this period of transition. 15 hr contract fixed till September 2020.
