Refuge Services

The Refuge offers safe and secure temporary accommodation for women and their children away from domestic abuse.

Refuge staff will work alongside women to support them to make informed choices about their housing, benefits and financial options. Staff will also support them to access other professional support such as legal, medical and debt advice.

Lighthouse has a dedicated children's team to support mums and children as they settle into the refuge. This includes, access to schools, nurseries and clinics, childcare, advice, play and individual support.



Refuge staff will endeavour to support women and their children to recover from the traumatic effects of domestic abuse and prepare them to live independently and safely in the future.

When women staying in the refuge are ready to move on Lighthouse can provide resettlement support to help with the transition of moving into their own home.

The Refuge:

Lighthouse refuge offers each woman/family their own bedroom with shared living rooms, kitchens, bathrooms and garden/play area.
